

HEPATITIS SCREENING CAMP IN GULISTAIN E SAIDA PRIMARY SCHOOL, GULBERG LAHORE

Maternity and Child Welfare Association of Pakistan organized Hepatitis screening camp with the collaboration of Bhandarah Foundation in Gulistain E Saida Primary School, Gulberg, Lahore on 15th March, 2017.

117 students and teachers of the school were screened for Hepatitis B & C. 01 teacher was found positive for Hepatitis C. general physical check-up of students was also conducted by Dr. Saima. Refreshment were distributed among students.



FREE MEDICAL / SCREENING CAMP AT VILLAGE MULLIAN KALAN

Maternity and Child Welfare Association of Pakistan (MCWAP) has started ambulatory medicine for poor and needy especially women and children. Health care services are provided to people at their door step.

We plan to conduct free medical camps in villages where there are no government / non-government medical facilities. A survey was conducted and two villages are selected to start with.

Our first such camp was arranged in village Malian which population of about 5,000 on 10th May, 2017. The nearest health facility available is 12km away. People / patients who don't have means keep suffering. Children remain unvaccinated.

Our team comprising three Doctors, one Lab Technician, one LHV, two TBA's, two Community Health Workers, four helpers was transported there in two vehicles along with medicines, furniture and lab equipment.

Mrs. Farzana Sami, President and Dr. Shagufta Zaidi, Director Technical also accompanied along with Mrs. Riffat Naeem, Joint Secretary.

Village numberdar and others welcomed our team. Attendance of patients was very good.

Following facilities were provided:

1. Patients examined and medicines provided to 85 patients.
2. Examination and Registration of Antenatal women.
3. Screening for Hepatitis B & C (61 patients)
4. Blood Sugar testing (61 patients)

25 persons were found hepatitis positive and 11 persons had high blood sugar(Diabetes).

Women attending the camp were also given talks on health related topics.

People of village appreciated the efforts of MCWAP. It was very good experience for MCWAP team.



FREE MEDICAL / HEPATITIS / SUGAR TESTING CAMP IN VILLAGE MALLAIN

Maternity and Child Welfare Association of Pakistan arranged 2nd free Medical / Hepatitis / Sugar testing Camp in village mallain off bedian road on 23rd May, 2017 as follow-up of previous camp on 10th May, 20117.

Maternity and Child Welfare Association of Pakistan team consisted of three senior specialist doctors, one lab technician, one LHV,two community midwives and four support workers.

Public response was very encouraging.

Following activities were conducted

1. Examination and treatment of patients
2. Examination and registration of pregnant ladies
3. Provision of medicines
4. Screening of Hepatitis B and C
5. Blood Sugar testing
6. Awareness session for hepatitis B and C positive patients
7. Guidance and arrangement for further management of hepatitis positive patients.

They were referred to Mayo Hospital, Lahore. Where arrangements are made for their further management including free tests and treatment.

Dr. Shagufta Zaidi, Director Technical gave awareness talk to Hepatitis positive patients. She explained the ways of prevention of further spread. The audience took keen interest.

BREAST CANCER AWARENESS SEMINAR

BREAST AWARENESS SEMINAR IN VILLAGE HAYER

Maternity and Child Welfare Association of Pakistan arranged a Seminar for creating awareness in the women about breast cancer in village Hayer.

More than 60 women attended the seminar. They were told about causes, diagnosis, management of breast cancer. Dr. Ubaida Nighat, Senior Public Health Specialist taught the participants the self palpatory method of diagnosing a lump in the breast and it's further management.

Dr. Shagufta Zaidi, Director Technical MCWAP explained that breast cancer is completely curable if detected in time. She further highlighted the high incidence of Hepatitis C and told them how to prevent this disease through awareness. Participants were also briefed about advantages of breast feeding. Participants were requested to spread the message to their relatives and friends.
